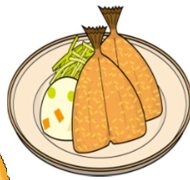
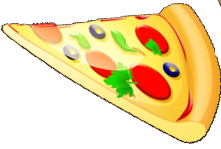

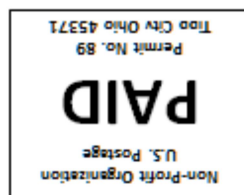
Bar Poker, Left-Right-Center
